Starry Starry Skies respects and will adhere to the safety policies of our host, Blue Bridge Repertory Theatre. Additionally, our safety protocols reflect the recommendations of local, provincial, and federal health authorities, and are designed to keep our staff and audience safe.

Masks

Staff will be wearing masks at all times. We ask that all guests wear masks when entering and exiting the facilities, and while in the lobby and washrooms. Guests may take off their mask once they are seated. If a guest does not have a mask, a reusable one will be provided for them. These masks will then be collected and properly washed/sanitized for the next performance. Exceptions for persons with respiratory issues as outlined by health authorities apply.

Social Distancing

We ask that our guests adhere to proper social distancing regulations as outlined by health authorities. This includes limiting the number of people in the lobby and washrooms at all times. The flow of traffic will be directed by the ushers.

Hand Sanitizer and Hand-washing

Staff will observe frequent hand washing and maintain a high level of individual sanitization. Hand sanitizing stations will be provided at the entrance to the theatre and throughout the facilities for guests and staff.

Venue Sanitation

Additional staff will be posted for the cleaning of washrooms and audience areas. The theatre seats will be disinfected after each performance.

Coughing May Occur

A member of the cast has a disorder called Cognitive Parasympathetic Nerve Disorder. This means that sometimes they cough involuntarily. To be extra cautious they were tested multiple times for COVID and all tests were negative.

Cast & Crew Safety

Members of the cast & crew who displayed COVID symptoms were tested and all the tests were negative. Members of the cast and crew who needed to have physical contact during the show chose to be part of one another's contact bubble at the beginning of the rehearsal process. Those who did not need to have physical contact wore masks and maintained social distance. Sanitization was provided at the entrance/exit of all rehearsal locations and washrooms were disinfected after each use.
